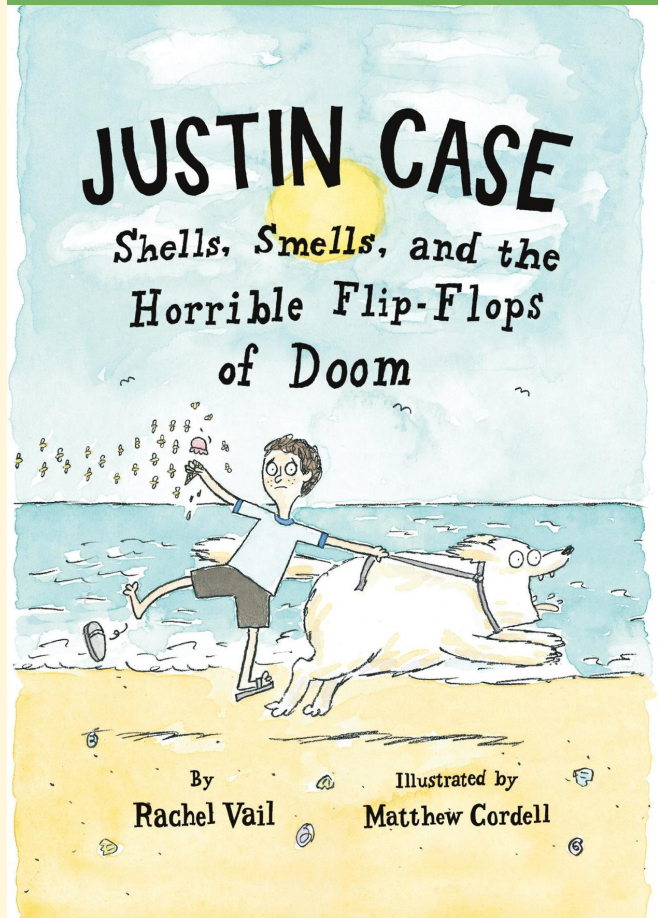

### Justin Case : Shells, Smells, and the Horrible Flip-flops of Doom

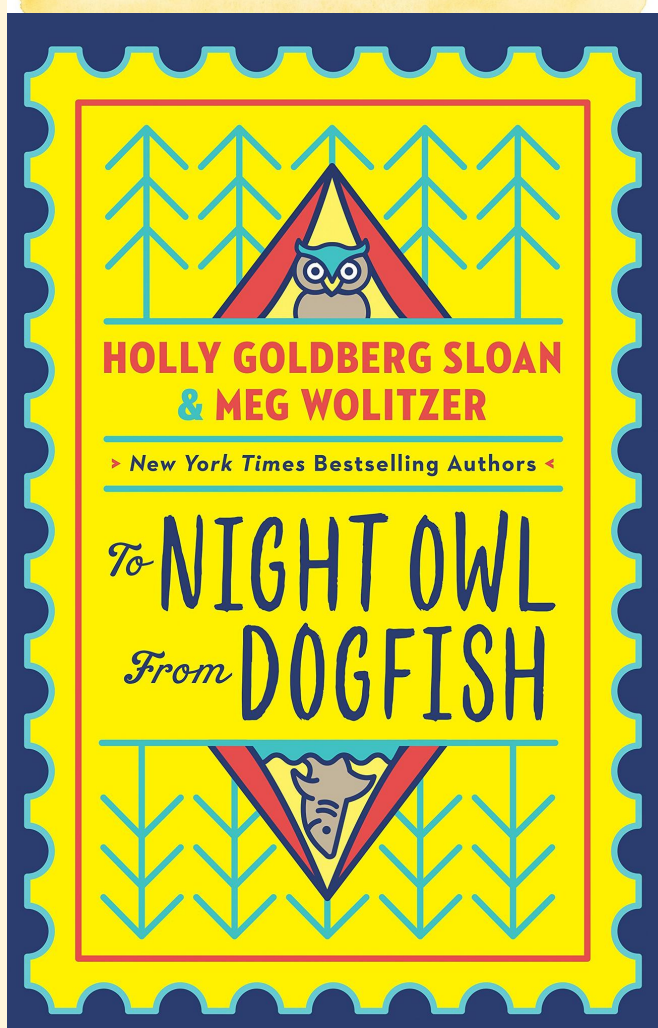
