Residents of the City of Thunder Bay pay for public library service in their property taxes.

Most people who don't live in the City of Thunder Bay, or do not pay taxes to the municipality, must pay an annual fee for a library card. There are some exceptions, as noted above -- in addition, business owners who pay property taxes within the City and who live outside City limits, are not subject to non-resident fees.
