#### **Tremendous Towers**

Students will explore and learn about the importance of building a structure in relation to its strength and stability. Through hands-on investigations, students design and build a tower, and then test its load-bearing function and ability to resist the forces of the wind!

#### **Tremendous Bridges**

Students are challenged to build a bridge that will span at least a meter. The goal is to use problem-solving skills to design and build a structure that will hold the most weight. In competitive fun, each bridge is tested with the application of weight in kilogram increments to see how it holds up. Students learn about the different parts of a bridge, and the important role each plays in contributing to its strength.
