Fast-paced: events in these exciting books unfold rapidly, moving the reader quickly through the story Gruesome: not for the squeamish, these books include a significant amount of explicit gore or other grisly elements.

High fantasy: With dragons, wizards, and questing heroes, these books fully embrace traditional fantasy storytelling.

They are set in alternate worlds filled with magic and fantastic creatures.

Historical fantasy: These stories feature magic, mythical creatures, and other fantastical elements...in otherwise recognizable historical settings and periods.

Plot-driven: events rather than characters propel these stories forward.

Romantic: not genre romances, but featuring strong romantic elements—either between characters or in the story itself

Steampunk: stylish retro-futurism evokes the society, politics, and clockwork aesthetics of the Industrial Revolution.

Suspenseful: ranging in intensity from subtle psychological unease to nail-biting suspense, these books keep readers on edge.

Unconventional: using unique or unexpected elements, these books may twist, adapt, or play on conventional storylines.

World-building: immerse the reader in vivid imaginary worlds of invented histories, languages, geography, or cultures.
